

APPENDIX C - CHILD PROTECTION REGULATION

Requirement for Counties, Members, Partners and other Organisations

Paragraphs 1 to 4 of the following regulation are to be included, under a child protection heading, into all organisations (including BADMINTON England's) Regulations, who are involved in Badminton in England and which provide the opportunity to work with children and young people.

- 1 The [name of host organisation], agrees to adopt the BADMINTON England Child Protection Policy and Implementation Procedures.
- 2. All individuals at all levels involved in Badminton through BADMINTON England, must abide by BADMINTON England's Child Protection Policy and the Code of Ethics and Conduct ('the Code') and all individuals, by participating or being involved in Badminton through BADMINTON England are deemed to have assented to and thereby adhere to the principles and responsibilities embodied in these documents.
- 3. Each and every constituent member of BADMINTON England including, without limitation, all clubs and leagues shall be responsible for the implementation of the Child Protection Policy and Procedures in Badminton in relation to their individual members.
- 4. Any act, statement or other behaviour that harms a child or group of children or poses a risk of harm to a child or group of children shall constitute conduct that is improper and thereby brings Badminton into disrepute. Such conduct will be dealt with, at the appropriate level, through the Disciplinary Procedure.

Requirement for affiliated Clubs and Leagues in England

All affiliated members of all host organisations including, without limitation, each and every club and league ("Affiliated Members") must include the following wording under a Child Protection heading within their rules:

"The (name of Affiliated Club / Member) agrees to adopt the BADMINTON England Child Protection Policy and Implementation Procedures. All individual members are deemed to have read understood and assented to the BADMINTON England Code of Ethics and Conduct ("Code") and as such recognise and adhere to the principles and responsibilities embodied in these documents."

Requirement for Individuals

All Affiliated Members shall ensure that the following wording is incorporated into all membership forms and all forms, contracts and/or terms of engagement regarding the appointment of coaches, officials and other individuals on a full-time, part time or volunteer basis:

"I, (name) have read and understood the BADMINTON England Child Protection Policy and Procedures and the Code of Ethics and Conduct ("Code") and as such agree to fully recognise and adhere to the principles and responsibilities embodied in both of these documents".
